



FEAPS Madrid renews its website thanks to Indra´s collaboration

**The second phase of the project will be undertaken next year,
with a focus on employment**

Madrid, 22 December 2010.- FEAPS Madrid has unveiled its new website (www.feapsmadrid.org) today, thanks to Indra´s collaboration, with a design that is more accessible and intuitive to use.

Thanks to the agreement between FEAPS Madrid and Indra, the two entities have been working together in recent months on a project of which the first phase has been implemented today.

The Federation´s new website offers visitors a cleaner design, a more dynamic home page, and the guarantee of relying on a Double-A Conformity Level of the W3C Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG-AA).

The website also includes the easily legible icon in order to guarantee the right to information for people with an intellectual disability. As a result, the FEAPS Madrid new website takes one more step forward and guarantees that all of its contents may be read in their normal version, and also in a more understandable format, without losing information.

One of the strengths of the new website is the section aimed at offering resources for people with an intellectual disability so they may carry out their quality of life project. As of today, they may access adapted documentation regarding their rights, as well as activities for leisure, time off and sports. However, without a doubt, it will be during the second phase of this joint project that will begin in January when this section will be expanded by placing an emphasis on employment for people with intellectual disabilities.

The new FEAPS website is more dynamic and intuitive, and its various sections are illustrated with characters whose creation has been made possible thanks to the volunteer efforts of the designers Laura Medina and Samuel Gonzalo.

- **FEAPS MADRID**, Federación de Organizaciones en Favor de Personas con Discapacidad Intelectual (Federation of Organisations in Favour of People with Intellectual Disabilities), is a public, non-profit organisation. It is currently made up of more than 32,000 families, organised in 96 entities, 309 centres and services that manage a total of 26,000 job positions, of which approximately 14,000 are with the Community of Madrid. Approximately 6,300 professionals work at the entities, along with the collaboration of nearly 1,500 volunteers.
